I would like to call your attention to an event to be held on Armed Forces Day (May 21, 2011) in Hampden County Massachusetts to honor the memory of Medal of Honor recipients whose final resting place is within the county. The American Legion Family together with other veteran's service organizations in the area have planned a tribute ride to and from each of these gravesites with a collation to follow. The attached documents contain the specific details.

As an FYI, Hampden County has a rich history with the Medal of Honor. We are the final resting place of seven recipients and six more entered the service from the county but are buried elsewhere.

It is our obligation to "never forget". As a stand-alone event, this will be an effective way to accomplish that goal. With it occurring a week before Memorial Day, we hope the added bonus is an increased awareness of the upcoming holiday to the general public.
